Assemblyman Bill Berryhill Endorses Brad Goehring in 11th Congressional District

*Local Republican who represents a large portion of San Joaquin County endorses

Stockton (CA) –Local Republican Assemblyman Bill Berryhill, who represents a large portion of the 11th district in the State Assembly, today announced his endorsement of Brad Goehring, a San Joaquin grapegrower, for the seat currently held by vulnerable democrat Jerry McNerney.

“Brad Goehring is the right person to send to Washington to clean up the mess and get the out of control spending back in line. Brad currently serves on the Board of the Lodi Woodbridge Winegrape Commission and the California Association of Winegrape Growers. Recognized statewide as a leader on agricultural issues, Brad serves as Director at Large for the San Joaquin County Farm Bureau and as national spokesman for the California Farm Bureau's work on the Clean Water Restoration Act.
