## **Goehring Endorsed by Ripon Councilmen Garry Krebbs and Dean Uecker.**

*Goehring campaign momentum continues to build solid support among local conservative leaders and elected officials. No other candidate in CD 11 has announced a single endorsement to date.*

**Stockton (CA)** –Grape grower and businessman Brad Goehring has received the endorsement of Ripon City Councilmen Garry Krebbs and Dean Uecker. This adds to an impressive lineup of local district support for Goehring among local conservative leaders and elected officials and highlights the weakness of the primary field.

“Brad Goehring is the only choice for conservative Republicans in the upcoming primary in the 11<sup>th</sup> Congressional District,” said Uecker. “He understands the importance of reigning in the out of control spending and waste in Washington that has hurt our economy and cost us jobs.
